
Annual Budget

The Niagara Symphony operates on a \$1.2 M annual budget which includes revenue from ticket sales, grants, education and fundraising streams.

42% of the Niagara Symphony's annual revenue is generated through fundraising efforts.

Of these fundraising initiatives, Corporate Sponsorship and Giving represents nearly half of this total, or 21% of the orchestra's overall revenue.

Our valued partners contribute to the overall financial success of the orchestra and ensure that our community continues to enjoy outstanding orchestral music for years to come.






The Niagara Symphony Audience

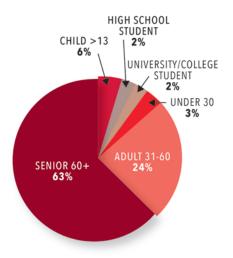
