Annual Budget

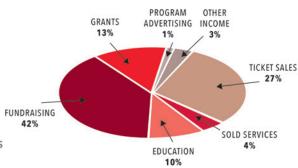
The Niagara Symphony operates on a \$1.5 M annual budget which includes revenue from ticket sales, grants, education and fundraising streams.

42% of the Niagara Symphony's annual revenue is generated through fundraising efforts.

Of these fundraising initiatives, Corporate Sponsorship and Giving represents nearly half of this total, or 21% of the orchestra's overall revenue.

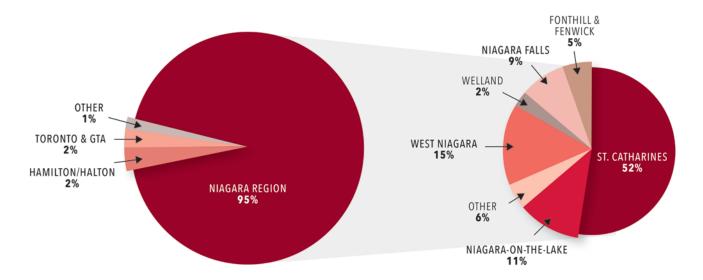


The Niagara Symphony Audience

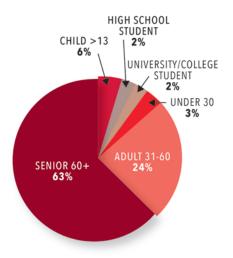

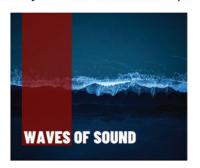

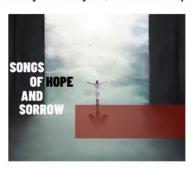
