Since 1962, the Niagara Symphony Orchestra (NSO) Summer Music Camp (SMC) has inspired and encouraged young musicians from the Niagara Region and beyond. We offer music instruction in a fun, inclusive day-camp atmosphere and welcome campers aged 4-15 of all backgrounds and abilities. Bursaries are available to those families who experience financial obstacles to the cost of their child attending camp, with a sliding-scale applied that can go to 100% of fees.

Campers enjoy a full and varied schedule that includes:

- Daily recitals featuring faculty and guest artists
- approx. 32 hours of Masterclasses in each two-week session
- Orchestral Ensemble participation
- Specialized, age-appropriate Early Years programming in both sessions
- Supervised outdoor recreation and daily crafts
- Every camper participates in SMC Concerts

- Help campers, apprentices, and volunteers work to their full potential and develop their confidence and musical skills.
- Maintain consistent standards of behaviour for all.
- Work with all faculty, staff, and volunteers to ensure the safety of all.
- Work co-operatively with all faculty, staff, and volunteers to ensure the highest standards of program delivery.
- Demonstrate respect for all members of the camp community and its property.
- Plan and prepare campers to perform (at minimum) one “classical” and one “pop” piece in the final camper concert.
- Perform in daily recitals as requested.
- Fulfill Music Appreciation, Lunch and Recess supervision as assigned.
- Participate in Final Concerts and Dress Rehearsals as required.
- Daily Attire: SMC Faculty T-shirt (will be provided)

- Experience in teaching music to children.
- Demonstrated leadership skills.
- A strong interest in music education.
- Professionalism, maturity and sensitivity to confidential information.
- A background in working with vulnerable sectors (youth, newcomers, and older adults) is an asset.
- Submit a current Vulnerable Sector Clearance Check (reimbursed upon submission of receipt).
